

IAHS Task Force on the Use of GRACE Data

[1 October 2008]

Terms of reference

- 1 To exchange experience within the Task Force and more widely within the IAHS community on the use of GRACE data for hydrological purposes;
- 2 To work with experts appointed by the International Association of Geodesy (IAG) with a view to IAHS and IAG organizing one or more joint sessions on this topic at the XXV IUGG General Assembly that will be held in Melbourne, Australia from 27 June to 8 July 2011;
- 3 To hold a side meeting during the IAHS/IAH Convention in Hyderabad in September 2009 to discuss these plans;
- 4 To discuss with our IAG counterparts both before and during the Melbourne Assembly what further joint activities that might be undertaken in this and related fields;
- 5 To keep the President and Secretary-General of IAHS informed of progress with this work, seeking their approval for any formal joint activities with IAG;
- 6 To report formally to the IAHS Bureau at its meetings in 2009, 2010 and 2011.
